6<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENT OF UNDERWATER FISHING

FOR THE EUROPEAN CLUBS CUP

Primorsko, 24 September 2006

## RULES

- 1. The International tournament for the **European Clubs Cup** will be held according to the C.M.A.S. International Rules, these Rules and the decisions of the Competition Jury.
- 2. Composition of the Jury:
  - The referee delegated by the C.M.A.S.;
  - The Director of the Tournament;
  - Two members elected between the team captains of the countries participating. The captain of the Bulgarian team may not be member of the Jury.

On the eve of the tournament, a conference of all captains, the competition director and the C.M.A.S. referee will be held to discuss these Rules and to elect two members of the Jury.

- 3. The organizer of the event, the Bulgarian Federation of Underwater Sports, shall not be liable for accidents of any nature suffered by any of the participants.
- 4. Each team will be composed of two competitors; one of them will be registered as the team captain.
- 5. Prior to the start of the competition, boats will be divided into two areas of the competition water area:

  Northern and Southern areas. Competitors shall have the right to chose between the boats. After the start, they inform the boatman of the area they have chosen.

- 6. The competition duration is fixed to 4 hours. The Jury may prolong this duration to 5 hours subject to a unanimous consent of the team captains.
- 7. Each club will be provided with a numbered bag for the draught.
- 8. The use of buoyshall be mandatory. The buoy shall be brightly colored. Under penalty of disqualification, the participants willnot be allowed to separate it from their bodies.
- 9. The use of fish-hooks is allowed but they must be attached to the buoy and not to the competitor's body.
- 10. Fish will be considered to be valid if they meet the following criteria:
  - be of a minimum weight of 300 g;
  - be caught by the competitor;
  - -be not of the species flat-bottomed, sturgeons, congers
    and sharks (Acipsnseridaes);
  - the draught of the following species is limited to:

    Triglidae 1 piece; Sparidae 5 pcs; Sciaena Umbra -10 pcs.
- 11. Where the weight of the fish exceeds 5 kg, the competitor will be awarded 5000 points, plus a bonus of 300 points. Now, the cup award for the fish of greatest weights is determined by the fish real weight.
- 12. Contesting may be made only by the team captain. It shall be submitted to the Jury in a written form accompanied with a fee paid of 100 €. This fee shall be returned to the claimer where the contesting is taken in consideration.
- 14. Security measures. Any of the competitors shall submit a certificate issued by his/her national federation attesting that he/she has passed the annual medical examination. The participants in the competition, regardless they are competitors, referees or technical staff, shall sign a special statement declaring that they do not participate on their personal responsibility. During the tournament, the security measures provide for the presence of two physicians and two skin-divers who will use two rapid boats. One ambulance car equipped with apparatuses and medicines for emergency aid will be located at Primorsko

- port. Each boat will be provided with a red flare for asking support where necessary.
- 15. Only those Bulgarian clubs which are members of the Bulgarian Federation of Underwater Sports may participate in the competition.
- 16. The organizers of the competition provide for awarding cups, medals and money prizes.
